SOURCING

- There is a historical link between Central Asia and the Valley Of Kashmir. Count almonds among the various bounties that were given to the valley by the region who were the first cultivators of the nut.
- Teardrop-shaped drupe counted in Nuts and mostly available in mixed dried fruits. Our Almonds (*Prunus Amygdalus Dulcis* Seed Oil) are Locally sourced from the Kashmir Valley, almonds are called by the name Badam. Cultivated using Grafting and Budding technique.
- Beauty seems to have been diffused in the air with the onset of Spring when the first tree-flowers to bloom are White-Pink in Hue. There is this mesmerizing charm all around, in the Month of March just because of the bloom of One single tree- The Almonds.

- Flaxseed oil is a rich source of essential fatty acids (EFAs): linoleic acid (ω -6) and α -linolenic acid (ω -3), which regulate prostaglandins synthesis, hence induce wound healing processes.
- Linseed oil has been claimed to be a super food (vegan source) that can provide omega 3 fatty acids for skin and hair rejuvenation.
- Reduces sensitivity and improves barrier functions.

- Black cumin, (*Nigella sativa*), also called black seed, black caraway, Roman coriander, kalonji, or fennel flower, annual plant of the ranunculaceae family (Ranunculaceae), grown for pungent seeds.
- The plant is sometimes grown as an ornamental for its attractive flowers and is closely related to love-in-a-mist (*Nigella damascena*), a more common ornamental.
- Sometimes hailed as a Panacea, black cumin seeds and their oil are widely used in traditional Ayurveda to treat a variety of ailments.
- It is sowed in November end, having a cultivation period of 110-150 days and harvested in the month of April or May.

- Coffee grounds make a great exfoliant. Grounds do not dissolve in water, which makes them good at scrubbing away dead skin cells.
- Caffeic acid, an antioxidant, may boost collagen levels and reduce the premature aging of cells.
- Caffeine stimulates blood flow and widens, or dilates, the blood vessels. This increases blood flow, which can help the skin to naturally tighten. The result may be a reduction in the buildup of fluid under the eyes. This is primarily due to the presence of Theobromine in it.
- Coffee contains antioxidants, such as polyphenols. These may help to protect against ultraviolet (UV) rays and signs of aging linked to sun exposure.
- Scrubbing the face with coffee grounds can help to clear away dead skin cells and unclog the pores.



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
